# The Mekong Seasonal Guide

More than a water highway, the mighty Mekong is a life-giving force, flowing through these stunning regions all year round. Our handcrafted itineraries allow you to enjoy the best of every season, each with their own unique delights.

## November to April

The 'dry season' is a popular time for river cruising on the Mekong. From December to February, spring flowers are in bloom and the locals are busy trading at the markets. The Vietnamese Lunar New Year, known as Tet Nguyen Dan (or Tet), is the most important time of the year in Vietnam, beginning either in late January or early February. Expect fireworks, pagodas bustling with worshippers and families gathering in celebration.



## May to October

Known as the 'green season', the region's verdant fields are nourished with intermittent monsoonal rain. If you prefer smaller crowds and a more relaxed pace, this is an ideal time of year to join our 9 Night Luxury Mekong Cruise which operates towards the end of the green season from July to September. Tet-Trung-Thu (Mid-Autumn Harvest) is also a significant festival for Vietnamese families, especially children.

Drift along the Mekong River during the day and enjoy the vibrant countryside and replenished air that comes with this special time of year.



## Rain and shine

For the dry season, expect abundant sunshine, blue skies and little chance of rain. As December to January brings slighter cooler temperatures, cultural and historic treasures can be explored in comfort.

During the green season, the region experiences its main rainfall, but most days you'll likely encounter short downpours in the morning or mid-afternoon, bringing a refreshing respite from the tropical heat. Lush landscapes burst with floral beauty and prominent birdlife, while there are fewer crowds across South East Asia's celebrated landmarks.






Tra Que Village

Return to the town of Tan Chau where you will have the option to experience a ride in a Xe Loi. This is a commonly used form of transportation in rural Vietnam and will lead you to the recently renovated Cao Dai temple. The religion of Cao Dai is a syncretic, monotheistic religion established in southern Vietnam in the city of Tây Ninh in 1926. Here, you will learn more about the mix of ideas that form the basis of this fascinating religion. 🍵🍵

Visit the workshops of Satcha: the first Cambodian handicraft centre that incubates local artisans, mixing traditional knowledge with contemporary design to showcase Cambodian talents. The aim is to help these artisans gain the know-how to develop their own business, thereby having a sustainable social, economic and environmental impact on the local community. 🍵🍵

**23 FINAL PROVISIONS, APPLICABLE LAW, JURISDICTION**

(1) The laws of the Federal Republic of Germany with the exception of UN sales law (United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods of 11 April 1980) shall govern these terms and conditions of travel. For travellers who are regarded as consumers this choice of law also applies provided that this does not deprive the traveller of the protection afforded by mandatory provisions of the law of the country in which he has his habitual residence.

(2) Disputes arising in relation to registered traders, persons who do not have a general place of jurisdiction in the Federal Republic of Germany, persons for whom, after the contract has been entered, their domicile or place of habitual residence is unknown at the date the action is lodged and actions where SCENIC is the defendant are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Lörrach. Both stipulations shall apply unless mandatory provisions of international conventions provide otherwise.

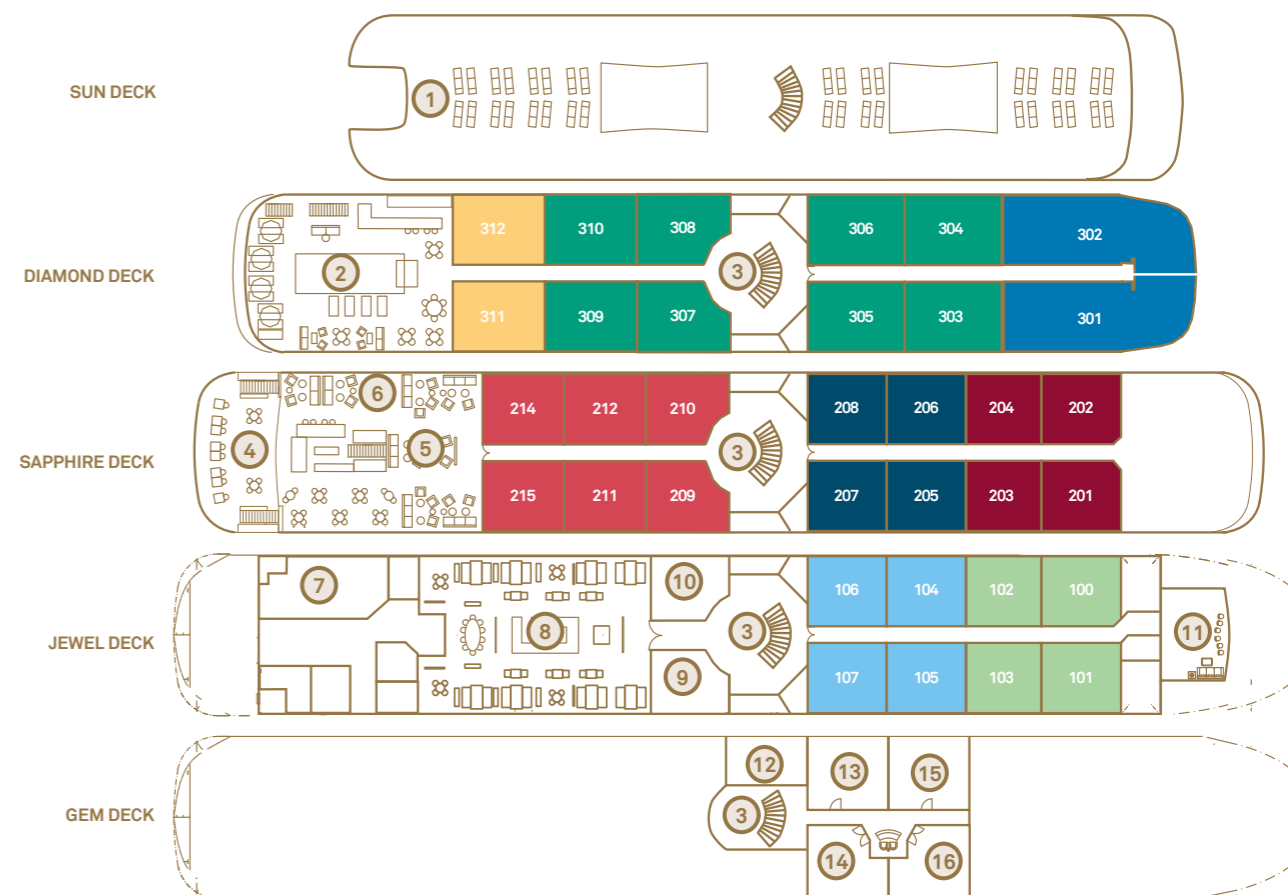
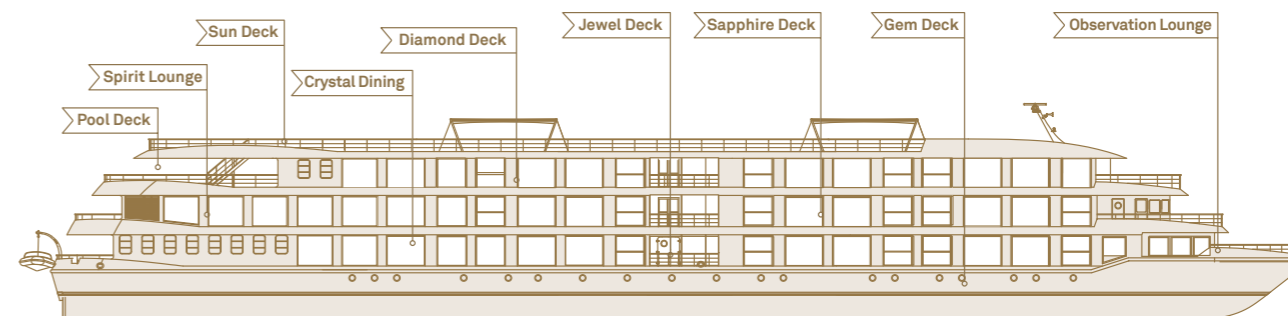
(3) For the remainder, unless otherwise agreed in these terms and conditions of travel, the statutory rules shall apply.

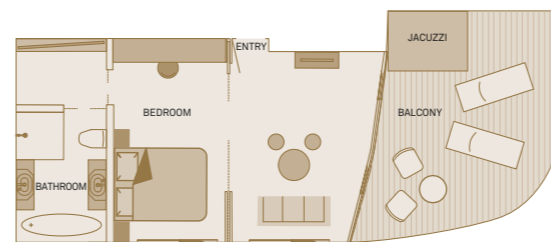

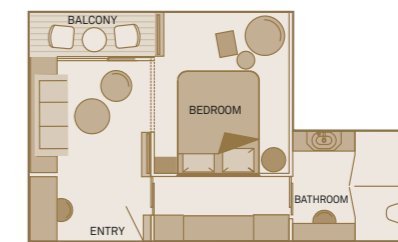

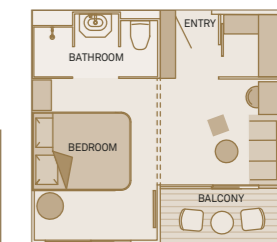
